SOLO PHYSICIAN PRACTICE

For solo physician practices, the physician is highly encouraged (but not required) to take the training within 12 months of initiating SBIRT services.

- As a solo physician, I, _____ (name of physician), attest to have completed the four hours of SBIRT training within 12 months of initiating SBIRT services.

SUPERVISING LICENSED PROVIDER

At least one supervising licensed provider per clinic or practice must take four hours of SBIRT training within 12 months of initiating SBIRT services.

- A. Licensed health care providers eligible to supervise staff are currently limited to licensed physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, or psychologist.
- B. On a continual basis beyond the first 12 months of service, at least one supervisor per clinic or practice must have completed training.
- C. If the attesting supervising licensed provider leaves a clinic or practice, the new supervising licensed provider must submit an attestation validating the completion of the four hour SBIRT training to Health Net within 12 months of initiating SBIRT services.

TRAINED, UNLICENSED PROVIDER

Trained, unlicensed providers, including, but not limited to, health educators, certified addiction counselors, health coaches, medical assistants, and unlicensed behavioral assistants, may provide SBIRT services if they meet the following requirements, which must be met before rendering services:

- A. Be under the supervision of a licensed provider limited to licensed physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, or psychologists.
- B. Completed a minimum of 60 documented hours of professional experience, such as coursework, internship, practicum, education or professional work within their respective fields. This experience should include a minimum of four hours of training directly related to SBIRT services (such as motivational interviewing).
- C. Completed a minimum of 30 documented hours of face-to-face client contact within their respective fields. (This requirement is in addition to the 60 hours of clinical professional experience described above.) This may include internships, on-the-job training, or professional experience and SBIRT services training.
